The Jay Brothers Unified Resource Center is a partnership of the 40 Bridgeport community agencies from the Bridgeport Re-Entry Roundtable that have come together to provide one-stop wrap around services for the anticipated returning citizens of the Bridgeport community.

The following services are available for program participants:

- Career resources
- Vocational training
- Educational and literacy services
- Transition to primary care services
- Recovery coaching services and peer mentoring
- Health and holistic wellness services
- Licensed behavioral health services including individual and group treatment; intensive outpatient treatment care; case management, crisis intervention, problem gambling treatment; psychiatric evaluations and medication monitoring.

The Jay Brothers Unified Resource Center is located on the East Side of Bridgeport and is accessible by car and directly on the Transit Authority bus line. Bus tokens are available for persons in need and parking is free with handicap accessibility.
